A Message from the CEO

When I set out to build Battle Buddy, I didn't begin with software or data. I began with Jack.

Jack was a Vietnam veteran we found living alone in a small deer shack after nearly a decade in isolation. When he returned home from war, he asked about his benefits —only to be told that because he had been drafted, he wasn't a "real" veteran. That single moment of dismissal shaped the rest of his life. Without access to care, resources, or guidance, he carried the invisible wounds of combat alone. His mental health deteriorated. He lost his family. And eventually, he lost his sense of identity and worth.

The day I took him for a haircut and a shave, Jack looked in the mirror and said it was the first time he had felt like a man in as long as he can remember. That moment wasn't about grooming. It was about dignity. About being seen. About finally receiving something he had earned decades before.

Jack is the reason we built Battle Buddy. Because the system wasn't built for him — and it still isn't build for millions of veterans today. For decades, we've approached veteran suicide from the wrong angle. We focus on screenings, questionnaires, and crisis indicators. But by the time a veteran answers "yes" on those forms, we are already too late. The real upstream solution begins much earlier — with stability, identity, and purpose.

When a service member leaves the military, the first question they face isn't a mental health assessment. It's: Where am I going to live? Stable housing, especially homeownership, is the foundation of long-term wellbeing. It creates roots, pride, and the sense of control that so many veterans lose during transition. Housing isn't just an economic issue; it is suicide prevention.

That is why Battle Buddy exists: to give veterans a clear starting point, a trusted guide, and a pathway toward stability from day one. What you can expect from Battle Buddy is simple:

- A veteran first platform that empowers rather than overwhelming
- Real-time access to benefits, housing resources, and financial guidance
- Tools that restore dignity, reduce confusion, and prevent crisis before they ever begin
- A community and a mission built for every Jack across this country who deserves better

Our promise at VETLIFE is straightforward:

No veteran will ever again be told they are not "real."
No veteran will ever have to navigate their benefits alone.
No veteran will be left behind on the path to stability, homeownership, and hope.

That real-time insight allows VETLIFE to step in earlier — before a breaking point, before a life unravels.

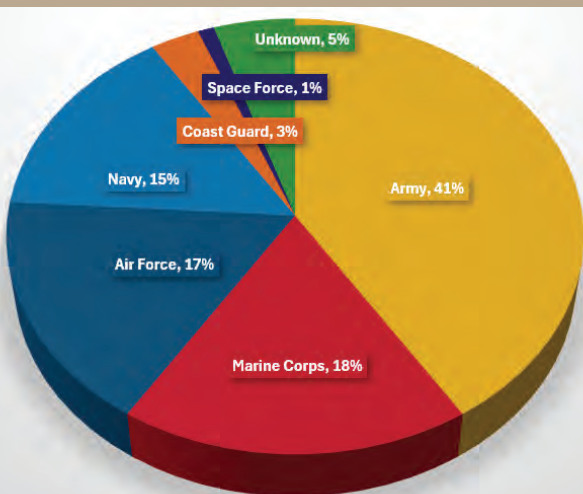
In Q1 alone:

- 19,267 chances to prevent crisis

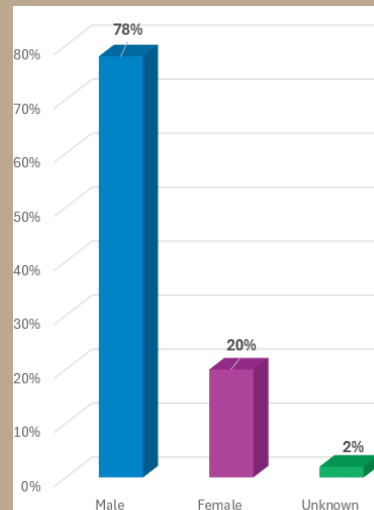
No government agency or nonprofit in America can do this. **VETLIFE can — and does.**

Q1 2025 Data Summary: Who We Served

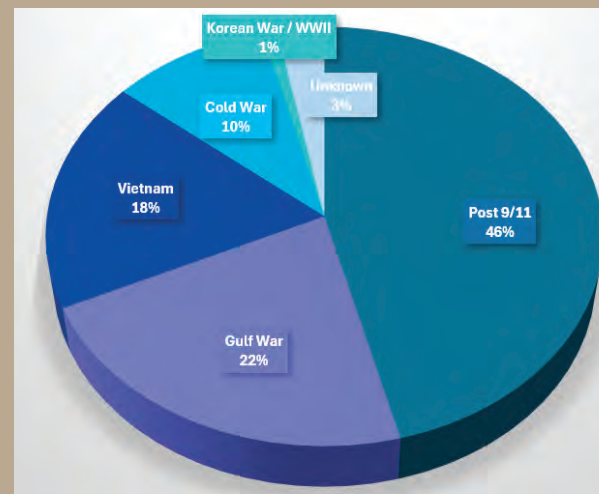
Branch of Service

Housing Stability Outcomes

- 87 veteran families connected to their VA Home Loan benefit
- 4 homeless veterans placed into long term stable housing



Mental Health & Crisis Prevention Outcomes

- 1,156 veterans engaged with mental health resources
- 856 spouses gained support
- 215 external referrals to Battle Buddy as a verified resource



Benefits Access Outcomes

- 3,765 veterans took action to begin or advance a disability claim

WHAT THIS TELLS US

These are upstream suicide prevention indicators. Veterans who secure housing, access benefits, and reduce confusion around navigation are significantly less likely to fall into crisis.

This is not crisis response — it is crisis prevention.

WHY Q1 MATTERS

Q1 confirmed that VETLIFE's model works — and revealed something unprecedented. **For the first time in history, we now have real-time data showing exactly where veterans are struggling**, what benefits they cannot access, and which unmet needs are emerging across communities nationwide. Traditional federal reporting, including VA data, is often 12-24 months behind. By the time those reports surface, the landscape has already changed, the opportunity to intervene has passed, and too many veterans have slipped through the cracks.

Battle Buddy eliminates that delay. Every download, every search, every benefit inquiry, and every referral creates immediate insight into what veterans need right now. Combined with VETLIFE's boots on the ground outreach, radio storytelling, and deeply engaged resource partners, this real time intelligence gives us a modern solution to long standing gaps in veteran care. Instead of reacting to crises reported years after the fact, we can finally address issues early — when support has the greatest impact.



LOOKING AHEAD: Investment Priorities for 2025-2026

To scale this model nationally, VETLIFE is seeking investment in the following high-impact areas:

1. Technology development and real time data infrastructure
2. Expansion of Battle Buddy into 6 new state pilots
3. Increasing home loan usage from 13% to 30% by 2030
4. Growing to 500,000 veterans on the platform by the year end
5. Expanding crisis prevention algorithms and support pathways
